DIESEL ENGINE STARTING PROCEDURE

- 1. PLACE GEAR SELECTOR IN EITHER "P" OR "N" POSITION.
- 2. TURN IGNITION KEY TO "RUN" POSITION. THE "GLOW PLUGS" LIGHT SHOULD ILLUMINATE INDICATING GLOW PLUG OPERATION.
- 3. IF THE "DON'T START" LIGHT HAS **NOT** COME ON:
 - DEPRESS ACCELERATOR PEDAL SLIGHTLY.
 - TURN KEY TO "START."

IF THE "DON'T START" LIGHT **HAS** COME ON:

- WAIT UNTIL IT GOES OUT.
- DEPRESS ACCELERATOR PEDAL AT LEAST HALF WAY.
- TURN KEY TO "START."

NOTICE: DO NOT TRY TO START ENGINE WITH "DON'T START" LIGHT ON; IN MOST CASES IT WILL ONLY DELAY STARTING.

- 4. RELEASE BOTH IGNITION KEY AND ACCELERATOR PEDAL WHEN ENGINE STARTS. THE "GLOW PLUGS" LIGHT SHOULD GO OUT WHEN ENGINE STARTS.
- 5. IF THE "GLOW PLUGS" LIGHT SHOULD REMAIN ON, OR IF THE LIGHT SHOULD COME ON DURING ENGINE OPERATION, SEE YOUR DEALER FOR REPAIRS TO PREVENT POSSIBLE ENGINE MALFUNCTION.
- 6. IF THE ENGINE HAS FAILED TO START AFTER 10 15 SECONDS OF CRANKING, RETURN IGNITION SWITCH TO "RUN" POSITION. REPEAT STEP 3.
